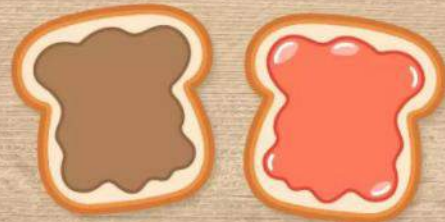

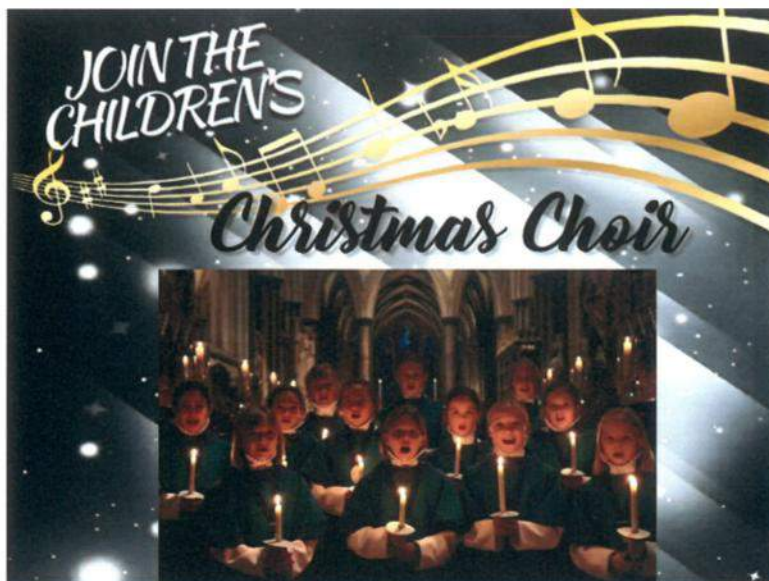

Angel Scholarship Fund- Back again in 2023!

The Angel Scholarship Fund (ASF) is a State of Ohio approved Scholarship Granting Organization. Donors to ASF may be eligible for a 100% tax credit on their State of Ohio income tax return for the year the contribution is made. The maximum credit amount is \$750 per individual; married couples that file a joint return can each claim this credit if both spouses make eligible donations (\$1,500 total).

Here's how it works: Donations to ASF may reduce tax payers' Ohio income tax liability on a dollar-for-dollar basis. That is, money that ordinarily would have been owed to the State of Ohio can be "redirected" to fund Catholic education scholarships.

Sample Net Result: Let's assume that, normally, after tax credits and deductions, a family's Ohio income tax is \$2,000. The example below illustrates the positive impact of a \$1,500 Angel Donation:


