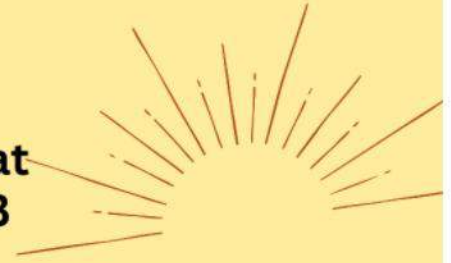

Dear Parishioners:

Thank you again for your ongoing support of the parish. By your sacrificial giving to this parish, and with the help of the finance council, we continue to be growing, and actively making disciples of Jesus Christ. Enclosed please find the year-end report for June 2023 along with the budget for year-ending June 2024.

Capital Expenditures of \$266,080 consisted of the following:

- Replacement of the parish center roof
- Outdoor Irrigation systems for the parish gardens.
- Gutter guards were installed on the rectory.
- Two new HVAC units were installed on the north and south side of the rectory.
- The Family Life Center roof was repaired and waterproofed.
- Upgrades to the Church restrooms got under way towards the end of the fiscal year.
- Equipment was purchased to clean the floors and carpeting on the campus.

Budgeted Capital Improvements for the 2023-2024 Fiscal Year includes:

- Completing the renovation of Church restrooms.
- Updating and enlarging the bride's room.
- Finishing the installation of irrigation systems in the parish gardens.
- HVAC replacements in the parish center and family life center.
- Replace the pavers in Mary's Garden and add a border.

The following budgeted items have already been completed:

- Replacement of the old exterior doors on the north and south side of the Church.
- The Church parking lot has been repaired, sealed and striped.

Over this past year a lighting architect for the Church has been hired, with the project hopefully to begin in January, and a new sound system has been installed as part of the Church renovation.

CATHOLIC CHARITIES UPDATE – 818 Donors – Pledging \$549,859 of which \$466,710 has been received.

ST. CECILIA MUSIC FUND UPDATE –130 donations – the year-end balance totaled \$86,709.50. At the end of this summer new microphones and stands were purchased from this fund totaling \$7,000.00.



Other things to note:

- We have had over 300 families join this parish in the past 18 months
- We have six young men in discernment and formation for the priesthood.
- Our largest cost involves salaries and benefits, totaling: \$1,141,200.00, these men and women work hard so that we can offer all the ministries, activities and events that make this parish an instrument for the Lord to bring about His kingdom through, with, and in us.

-Several of our deceased members have made sure to have left us a legacy gift, which is enabling us to plan, and think into the future with confidence and new possibilities, so a big thank you to those who have gone before us.

In short, while we are still a parish, and money needs to be counted, and we are never simply “fine,” we are doing well, and I am grateful to each of you and God for making this possible. Please continue to remember St. Basil’s in your financial planning so that we can make disciples now, and in the future, for Jesus came to give everyone, “Life, life to the full” (Jn 10:10).

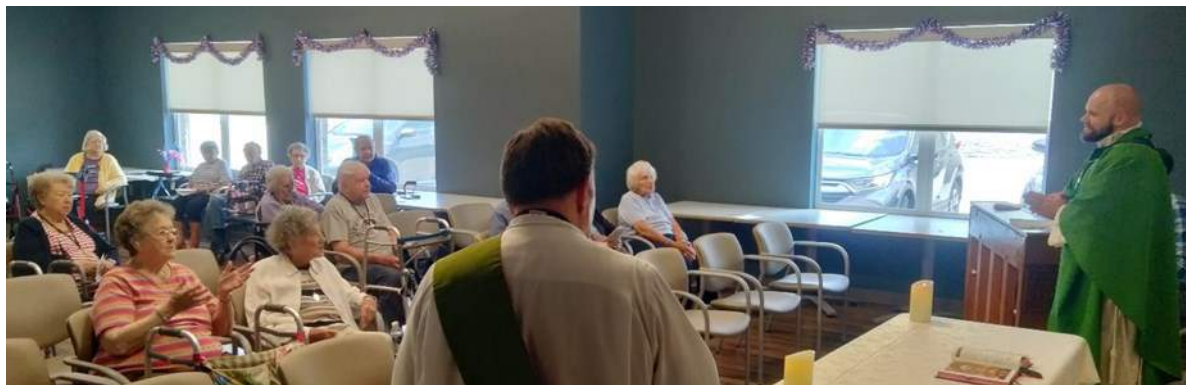
