What is an Advent Wreath?



Advent Wreaths are traditionally constructed with evergreens in a circle, inserting 4 candles representing the four weeks of Advent.

Three candles are purple and one rose candle are inserted- All white candles may be used. The purple candles represent prayer, penance and charitable works undertaken during the Advent Season. The rose candle is lit on the third Sunday of Advent (Gaudete Sunday) Gaudete Sunday means "rejoice" and this marks the halfway point until Christ's birth at Christmas. The lighting of the Advent Wreath reminds us of the expectation and hope of our Lord's first coming into the world at Christmas and fills us with anticipation of our Lord's second coming at the end time.
