





On the first Sunday of the month, Mary Queen of Peace in Parish opens their doors at noon to about 100 parishioners for this meal. Father Doug Brown, a former St. Basil priest, says Mary Queen of Peace Church is important in the lives of so many as a significant part of the Old Brooklyn neighborhood.

SVDP thanks Sharon Wolf who has been planning, purchasing, preparing, and delivering delicious meals monthly for nearly two years to Mary Queen of Peace and other places that serve the poor. Sharon says this is a ministry, separate from her full time employment. Her home-cooked, hot entrees delight the parishioners. In recent months she served roast pork, sauerkraut, and mashed potatoes; BBQ chicken with Spanish rice and corn on the cob; and lasagna, salad and roll; and tops the meals off with cinnamon-glazed apples, or homemade combread or cookies.

What is an Advent Wreath?



Advent Wreaths are traditionally constructed with evergreens in a circle, inserting 4 candles representing the four weeks of Advent.

Three candles are purple and one rose candle is inserted- All white candles may be used. The purple candles represent prayer, penance and charitable works undertaken during the Advent Season. The rose candle is lit on the third Sunday of Advent (Gaudete Sunday) Gaudete Sunday means "rejoice" and this marks the halfway point until Christ's birth at Christmas.

The lighting of the Advent Wreath reminds us of the expectation and hope of our Lord's first coming into the world at Christmas and fills us with anticipation of our Lord's second coming at the end time.


COLLECTION OF PERSONAL HYGIENE ITEMS FOR VETERANS- VETERANS DAY 2023




