





2024 will be Year of Prayer, says Pope



"I wanted next year, in preparation for the 2025 Jubilee, to be entirely dedicated to prayer. Next year will be dedicated to prayer," he told those who attended the Angelus last Sunday.

The Pope said that "guides" will be published, "which will help rediscover the centrality of prayer."

"I recommend them to you: they will be a good read, which stimulate prayer with simplicity and in accordance with Christ's heart."

The Holy Father called for a daily renewal of the "joy and commitment" of "being men and women of prayer. Prayer that comes from the heart, not like parrots. No. From the heart. May the words that are spoken come from the heart."


