The Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord

The Epiphany marks the arrival of visitors, identified in Scripture as the magi, to the place where Jesus was born. Although we know virtually nothing about them, we do know they brought three gifts:

- 1. Gold a symbol of wealth and power, identifies the recipient as a king.
- Frankincense the crystalized resinous sap of a tree used as incense and as an offering, is symbolic of prayer.
- Myrrh another resinous tree sap, was used in healing liniments and as an embalming ointment. Myrrh is an odd gift for a child—so, even at the beginning of Jesus' life on earth, this gift foreshadows his death.

Reflect


For much of the secular world, the holiday season has died down. Reflect with this article on the joys of the holiday season and what you have left to celebrate when the decorations are put away.



Our Cancer Support Group welcomes all who have been touched by cancer in some way. Patients,





Lessons from Laudate Deum: Apostolic Exhortation to all people of good will on the climate crisis

Courage to Change

"... in other themes related to the environment, when there was a will, very significant results were obtained, as was the case with the protection of the ozone layer. Yet, the necessary transition towards clean energy sources such as wind and solar energy and the abandonment of fossil fuels, is not progressing at the necessary speed.

We must move beyond the mentality of appearing to be concerned but not having the courage needed to produce substantial changes. We know that at this pace in just a few years we will surpass the maximum recommended limit of 1.5° C and shortly thereafter even reach 3° C with a high risk of arriving at a critical point. Even if we do not reach this point of no return, it is certain that the consequences would be disastrous and precipitous measures would have to be taken, at enormous cost and with grave and intolerable economic and social effects. Although the measures that we take now are costly, the cost will be all the more burdensome the longer we wait." Laudate Deum

What does Pope Francis mean when he writes that we must move from appearing to be concerned to having the courage to produce substantial changes? What will motivate you to step into the unknown? Is it the future of your children and grandchildren, care for the poor and "neighbors" in remote regions of the world or perhaps care for God's creatures?
