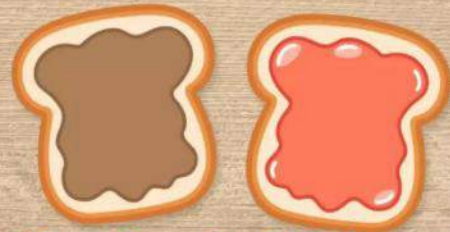
### Catholic University Collection: 20-21 January 2024


