Another Chapter

Recently my spiritual director told me that my life has been a series of comings and goings. That one comment brought clarity to my own future and my spiritual journey.

To understand how that comment impacted me, you would have to embrace the spiritual truth, each of us have been created and gifted by God for a purpose (Eph. 2:10 & Ps. 139:16). Growing up in a Pre-Vatican II Church, that truth was unknown to me. My faith was practiced more than lived until Anne and I, newly married, moved to Charlotte, N.C. There we entered a church that had implemented the reforms of Vatican II, and we encountered people whose belief in a loving God was evident and who worshipped during mass. I knew instantly I was deficient and knew I desired to believe as they believed. To worship as they worshiped and to feel God's presence daily.

That desire turned into a quest to discover and encounter Jesus who gave up His life so that I could live. There were no programs like we have today to help guide and shape our faith. My pursuit to discover God was intellectual which left me wandering in a wilderness of confusion and desire. So, I did the next best thing and that was to volunteer. I became active: service to the community by works of kindness but I continued to struggle with a desire to encounter God.

My life up to this point involved a series of moves. Before my eighteenth birthday my family had moved three times. Anne and I married and over the next twenty years we lived in Charlotte N.C., Malaysia, Vermont, eastern N. Carolina, Singapore, Avon Lake Ohio, Brecksville, Knoxville, and Broadview Heights. With each move we left behind friends, routines, and predictability. What we faced was starting over, uncertainty and new experiences. All the while I was still striving to move my faith from my head to my heart. Ten years after Charlotte in Vermont I realize a simple truth and that was to stop trying and invite God into my life. On a Saturday summer morning, I drove alone up into the Green Mountains and sat on a rocky overcrop all day until I finally said yes to whatever God was calling me to do. I felt relieved and frightened but knew God was there with me.

I began reading the scriptures and began a personal prayer life walking, talking, and listening to God who was revealing His love and mercy to me. That year was 1973, ten years after encountering the community of St. Ann's in Charlotte. I began giving talks around the Diocese creating a desire in others to encounter a loving merciful God. It was then that my pastor talked to me about becoming a Deacon. Little did I know God was still working on me and let me know it was not time to take that step. The next twenty years were years of spiritual growth and formation. Lesson learned was to never underestimate the impact your faith has on someone who is searching.

Now it is time for another move. Not away but a more defined focus. After discussion with my Spiritual Director and Fr. Ryan I'm changing the ways I minister here at St. Basil the Great. I will continue to pray with those who need to know God care, counsel individuals as they are struggling with their own brokenness, guiding individuals spiritually and give talks when invited. I will continue to be on the baptism schedule and as I have always tried to do, I will be open to where the Lord may be leading me in the future.

It has been my pleasure to serve you and you will never realize how much I have cherished your trust, your support,

and your prayers over the years.



Widowers Meetings


