Donati St. Vince Helps

Donations to St. Basil's St. Vincent de Paul (SVDP) Helps Those in Need

Imagine you parked your car downtown and while walking to a Guardians game with your family or friends, someone stops you and asks for money. What should you do? Thoughts running through your mind are that you want to help, but you don't want to be taken advantage of, or possibly endanger yourself, or feed an addiction. As a Catholic helping those who come to us in need is central to our faith. The Corporal Works of Mercy are described in Matthew 25. Jesus savs, "Whatever you did for one of these least brothers of mine, you did for me. For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, a stranger and you welcomed me, naked and you clothed me, ill and you cared for me, in prison and you visited me."

So what should you do? How you respond is a personal decision. Whether you give money to the person asking for help on the street, direct the person to the SVDP at St. Patrick's Church on Bridge Ave., or direct the person to the West Side Catholic Center on Lorain and W. 32nd St. for daily meals, clothing, and services is your decision. The U.S. Conferences of Bishops suggest people donate money to organizations that have the ability to provide support and services. St. Basil SVDP supports several inner city SVDP Conferences to help the poor through our "twinning" program.

Please consider donating to St Basil's SVDP and help us help those who come to us for emergency assistance. We are humbled and very grateful for the generosity of our faithful St. Basil parishioners who support us and thank everyone who contributes to help the poor. Together we pray for the poor and ask St. Vincent de Paul to pray for us!


