for the blessings of the upcoming season, we are

excited to announce the opening of our RCIA program for the new year. The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is a journey of faith, exploring the depths of our Catholic tradition, and welcoming new members into our vibrant parish community.

What is RCIA?

RCIA is a process designed for individuals interested in becoming Catholic or learning more about the Catholic faith. Whether you are seeking Baptism, Holy Communion, or Confirmation or simply wish to deepen your understanding of the Catholic Church, RCIA offers a supportive and enriching path.

Who Should Consider RCIA?

Inquirers: Those who are not yet baptized but wish to learn more about the Catholic faith. Candidates: Those who have been baptized in another Christian tradition and wish to join the Catholic Church.

Catechumens: Those who are baptized Catholics but have not yet received the sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist.

What to Expect?

Participants will embark on a spiritual journey with fellow seekers and parish mentors, engaging in weekly sessions that include prayer, discussion, and reflection. The RCIA process is a mix of formal instruction and personal exploration, culminating in the reception of the sacraments of initiation at the Easter Vigil.


How to Get Involved?

AUG 6: FEAST OF THE TRANSFIGURATION

At the Transfiguration, Jesus revealed His divine glory to three of His apostles: Peter, James, and John. Jesus took the apostles up a high mountain, where He was transfigured before them. His face shone like the sun, and His clothes became dazzling white. Moses and Elijah appeared alongside Him, representing the Law and the Prophets, and they spoke with Jesus.

To celebrate the feast:

- Pray the Luminous Mysteries of the Rosary, or just a decade reflecting on the Transfiguration while praying. (Matthew 17:1-8) Bonus: Go on a rosary walk or hike while praying, just as Jesus and His disciples hiked up the mountain to pray!
- Make snow cones! We hear in Mark 9:3 "His clothes became dazzling white, such as no fuller on earth could bleach them." Jesus' clothes became as white as snow and we can celebrate with a fun treat!
 - To make the sauce take 1 cup of fruit (fresh or frozen) and combine in a saucepan with 2-3 tablespoons of sugar until the fruit has softened and sugar has dissolved. Blend the fruit mixture until smooth and allow to cool completely. We chose pineapple and mango for a yellow color because we hear in Matthew 17:2 "his face shone like the sun."
 - Take ice and put it in a high powered blender to shave. If the ice is having trouble, add a tiny splash of water to help loosen it.
 - Top with your sauces! You can purchase snow cone syrup, or use the homemade version.


