

blessings of the upcoming season, we are excited to announce the opening of our RCIA program for the new year. The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is a journey of faith, exploring the depths of our Catholic tradition, and welcoming new members into our vibrant parish community.

What is RCIA?

RCIA is a process designed for individuals interested in becoming Catholic or learning more about the Catholic faith. Whether you are seeking Baptism, Holy Communion, or Confirmation or simply wish to deepen your understanding of the Catholic Church, RCIA offers a supportive and enriching path.

Who Should Consider RCIA?

Inquirers: Those who are not yet baptized but wish to learn more about the Catholic faith.

Candidates: Those who have been baptized in another Christian tradition and wish to join the Catholic Church.

What to Expect?

Participants will embark on a spiritual journey with fellow seekers and parish mentors, engaging in weekly sessions that include prayer, discussion, and reflection. The RCIA process is a mix of formal instruction and personal exploration, culminating in the reception of the sacraments of initiation at the Easter Vigil.

How to Get Involved?

If you are interested in joining the RCIA program or know someone who might be, please get in touch with our RCIA coordinator, Fr. Liptak, or visit our parish office. We will hold an introductory meeting on August 26th at 7:00 PM in the Family Life Center, where you can learn more about the process, meet the team, and ask any questions you may have.

We invite everyone to pray for those who are considering this journey, that they may be guided by the Holy Spirit and find a welcoming home in our parish community.

Let us come together in faith, hope, and love as we support those taking these first steps on their spiritual journey. May this be a time of growth and transformation for all involved.

St. Basil Parishioners' Generosity to SVDP Helps Feed the Poor at Inner-City Centers

"Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you or see you thirsty and give you drink? When did we welcome you away from home or clothe you in your nakedness?"

-Matthew 25: 37–38

Through your generosity and support, St. Basil's St. Vincent de Paul Society (SVDP) feeds the poor and marginalized in several Inner- City Centers each month. Examples include:

One hundred people enjoy monthly hot meals at Mary Queen of Peace Parish. On behalf of SVDP, Sharon & Joe Wolf prepare and deliver delicious, home-cooked meals to the community! Chicken salad, pasta, and brownies; sloppy joes, mac n' cheese, watermelon and cookies; teriyaki chicken kebob, garden vegetable rice and vegetable medley, rolls and juicy clementines were on the menu this Summer. St. Basil's Social Concerns' members along with parishioners who volunteer through parish Sign-Up-Genius, prepare a home-cooked brunch of French toast or pancakes, bacon or sausage, and fruit at the Moriah House Family Shelter at West Side Center.

Bishop Cosgrove Hunger Center benefits from our funding and our St. Basil St. Catherine's Food Pantry provides SVDP with bags of food for those who come to us for emergency assistance.

Pope Francis expresses his gratitude and affirms the importance of SVDP in our time. He quotes St. Vincent de Paul, "When you visit the poor, you encounter Jesus". St. Basil's SVDP continues our mission to feed the hungry and welcome those in need to a table of plenty. We are humbled and grateful to all our parishioners for your donations.
