


Separated and Divorce Educational Support Group

This weekend's Gospel always reminds me of the need to take notice of what we have to be grateful for. When it comes to wanting more, I am very guilty of discontentment with the things I have. Most of us are guilty of this. We see cars we want, vacations we wish we could take, and jobs we think we would be happier in, sometimes on a daily basis. Usually, this only serves to make us sad, jealous, and self-focused. In today's Gospel, John the Baptist is challenging us to give things away or, at the very least, to not gain more through extortion or manipulation. The deeper call that I see is not only to be content and grateful for what we have, but to use our time and energy to focus on serving others more than ourselves. It is good to grow, want more for ourselves, and have goals for our lives! However, if this is not balanced, it can lead to discouragement. If you have not heard of "The Allegory of the Long Spoons," the parable explains that Hell is a long banquet table of all the best food that you could ever want. The only problem is that you are forced to eat the food with spoons that are too long and unwieldy to get the food into your own mouth, and so you starve. Heaven is the same thing, but everyone is feeding the people around them and, consequently, everyone is nourished. Sometimes, our mental health suffers because of a hyperfocus on ourselves, the deficits in our lives, and the things we want but do not have. Our mental health tends to benefit when we can shift that focus to serving and loving others. If this message resonates with you, consider reflecting on ways that you can balance serving others and yourself to find the peace that John the Baptist is calling us to. -Luke Brown


