Stained Glass Spotlight

The stained-glass window of the Holy Spirit at St. Peter's Basilica is an awe-inspiring masterpiece that captures the profound theological and spiritual significance of divine presence. The dove, from wing tip to wing tip is six-feet wide, which puts into perspective its colossal size. In 2013, I travelled to Rome with 100 parishioners, however, sadly, I don't remember seeing this window. We were there during the busy season and our tour was very rushed. I'm grateful to be able to reflect on this window more than twenty years later and I look forward to returning some day and gazing upon this masterpiece. Located above the Chair of St. Peter, this window was designed by Gian Lorenzo Bernini in the 17th century, blending Baroque artistry with sacred symbolism. The window portrays the Holy Spirit as a dove, surrounded by golden light and cherubs. The warm hues of amber and gold emanating from the glass create a sense of divine light and warmth.

Having some time to reflect on this, I feel this window is a portrayal of the Holy Spirit's role as a guide, comforter, and source of divine inspiration. The Holy Spirit is a gift from God, and we need to open ourselves up to receive it, and we do. After being here at St. Basil for almost 19 years, I can tell you that I feel the Holy spirit moving and breathing here, especially when we worship. We are so blessed.

I imagine for those who stand before it, this stained-glass window is more than a piece of art; it is a call to contemplation and spiritual renewal. It reminds individuals to seek the guidance of the Holy Spirit in their daily lives and to act as instruments of God's love and wisdom in the

world. Ultimately, this work embodies the Church's message of hope, faith, and divine grace, inspiring all who gaze upon it to embrace the light of the Spirit in their hearts. I invite you to spend some time reflecting on this window, and I pray you seek the Holy Spirit every day to guide, comfort and





inspire you.

WHY IS GROUNDHOG DAY CELEBRATED ON FEBRUARY 2ND?

TODAY!

Many people are gearing up for Groundhog Day, when eyes are on *Punxsutawney Phil* to learn if six more weeks of winter or an early spring is on the horizon.

The origins of Groundhog Day date back to German settlers in the 1800s and the celebration of the Christian festival of Candlemas, held on February 2nd. Candlemas is the midpoint between the Winter Solstice and Spring Equinox, and early Christians believed that a sunny Candlemas meant 40 more days of cold and snow. Looking to a groundhog to predict the weather has it's roots in European lore, where "...a badger or sacred bear..." prognosticates the weather instead. German immigrants brought Candlemas traditions with them, but instead of using a badger, a groundhog was chosen.


