Fained Glass

While I haven't seen this exact window in person, I had the unique experience of contemplating this image almost daily when I previously worked at the Catholic Cemeteries Association for the Diocese of Cleveland. The Assumption of Mary, as this window beautifully portrays, is the logo for the cemeteries, and a powerful reminder of what God's promise is for those who follow Him. He promises to one day lift our entire being, body and soul, into Heaven.

Our physical bodies are part of God's beautiful creation, yet that world seems determined in making us believe our bodies are a source of weakness or even ugliness at times. The world is constantly pushing new drugs, new procedures, new supplements, new anything that will help us "cheat the system" and prevent our bodies from aging or getting sick.

This image tells us something different. Mary was fully human and therefore fully subject to the tolls time takes on the body. Yet, when it was time for her to join her Son in Heaven, God didn't leave her body behind. Instead, He showed us the sacred reality that our body and our soul were not designed to be permanently separated. Our bodies are sacred. How we treat our bodies matters. What we do with them matters. How we view our own body matters. We are called to love our bodies despite whatever changes age, illness, or life circumstances may bring.

For me, the image of the Assumption fills me with peace and has helped repair my relationship with my body. It reminds me that my body is part of God's creation, and everything God creates is beautiful. For anyone who is struggling to accept and love their body, whatever the circumstances, I hope this image brings you the same comfort and hope that it has brought me.





WHAT IS LENT?

Ash Wednesday begins the 40 days before Easter Catholics call Lent. We practice prayer, fasting, and sacrifice.

WHAT ARE FASTING AND ABSTINENCE?



Fasting

Catholics who are 18-58 years old are required to keep a limited fast: a single, normal meal & 2 snacks.



Abstinence

Catholics 14 years & older are required to abstain from eating meat and fowl.

Do I have to give up something for Lent?

No. Giving something up is a beneficial custom. You can give up something you enjoy, engage in physical or spiritual acts of mercy for others, pray, fast, abstain, go to confession, and other acts expressing repentance in general.


What is Lent?

Lent is a 40 day season of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving that begins on Ash Wednesday and ends at sundown on Holy Thursday. It's a period of preparation to celebrate the Lord's Resurrection at Easter. During Lent, we seek the Lord in prayer by reading Sacred Scripture; we

serve by giving alms; and we practice self-control through <u>fasting</u>. We are called not only to abstain from luxuries during Lent, but to a true inner conversion of heart as we seek to follow Christ's will more faithfully. We recall the waters of baptism in which we were also baptized into Christ's death, died to sin and evil, and began new life in Christ.

Many know of the tradition of abstaining from meat on Fridays during Lent, but we are also called to practice self-discipline and fast in other ways throughout the season. Contemplate the meaning and origins of the Lenten fasting tradition in this <u>reflection</u>. In addition, the giving of alms is one way to share God's gifts—not only through the distribution of money, but through the sharing of our time and talents. As St. John Chrysostom reminds us: "Not to enable the poor to share in our goods is to steal from them and deprive them of life. The goods we possess are not ours, but theirs." (Catechism of the Catholic Church, no. 2446)

In Lent, the baptized are called to renew their baptismal commitment as others prepare to be baptized through the <u>Order of Christian Initiation of Adults</u> (OCIA), a period of learning and discernment for individuals who have declared their desire to become Catholics —USCCB
