

All Souls Memorial Book

You will find the *All Souls Memorial Book* on the lectern near the statue of St. Joseph in the church. You can write the names of all of your loved ones who have passed away recently or over the years in the Memorial Book. They will be in our prayers.

What is All Saints' Day? (November 1) The liturgical calendar of the Church is punctuated by various feast days of saints. On these days, we ask in a special way for the intercession of these holy men and women. We also honor their cooperation with God's grace and seek to imitate their lives. We may also read some of their writings or pray in a way which was particularly loved by that saint.


There are too many saints to honor specifically by name and there are only 365 days in a year. And, as mentioned, there are more saints in Heaven than only the ones known by name. So, the Church celebrates All Saints' Day each year to commemorate each individual in Heaven: those known by name and those known to God alone. *(Not a Holy Day of Obligation this year.)*



What is All Souls' Day? (November 2) On the other hand, All Souls' Day is a commemoration of all the faithful departed, including those still undergoing the purification of purgatory. While All Saints' Day is a holy day of obligation, All Souls' Day is not. However, it is still a beautiful celebration that sets aside one day to pray, in particular, for the holy souls in Purgatory as they undergo the cleansing fire of God's grace in anticipation of Heaven.

This All Saints' Day, let us joyfully look forward to one day joining the company of the holy ones of God in Heaven. And this All Souls' Day, may we pray ardently that the holy souls in Purgatory might fully be cleansed of all attachment to sin and proceed to their eternal reward. *(Not a Holy Day of Obligation.)*

While it may sound cliché, I truly cannot say it enough—thank you for your continued generosity to the parish community of St. Basil the Great. Your kindness has touched countless lives this year, reaching those in need and supporting vital causes both near and far. Because of your unwavering support, we've been able to respond to urgent needs and make a meaningful impact throughout our community.

As we celebrate the completion of the Church renovation, we are reminded of the spirit of giving that made it all possible. Your generosity continues to inspire and strengthen our parish, and we are deeply grateful for the compassion and commitment you share with St. Basil the Great.

Social Outreach 2024–2025

- **Food Pantry** – A total of **\$30,165** was donated, along with consistent monthly food contributions. Sandwich Saturdays also helped keep local agencies stocked to serve those experiencing hunger.
- **Honduras Lenten Alms Collection** – Parishioners contributed **\$11,155** to support school improvements, orphanage needs, and water system repairs.
- **St. Vincent de Paul Society** – Through your generosity, **\$63,500** in annual donations were received to help those in need.
- **Blanket Sunday (SVDP)** – Parishioners provided **855 special request items**, and **\$4,300 in donations** which were distributed across **9 local organizations**.
- **St. Basil Giving Tree 2024** – Over **520 gifts** were donated, along with **\$21,585 in gift cards** and cash, benefiting **13 charitable organizations** throughout Northeast Ohio.
- **St. Michael/Scranton Boiler Repair Fund** – The St. Basil Music Ministry's "A Night of Beauty" Concert raised **\$13,332** to support boiler repairs at St. Michael on Scranton Rd.
- **Womankind** – A total of **\$9,478** was raised to assist women in need of prenatal care and support.
- **Catholic Charities 2025** – An incredible **\$663,405.48** was raised from **719 donors**, reflecting the deep commitment of our parish to the broader Catholic outreach.

Capital Expenditures and Facility Updates

- **Livestreaming Technology** – Automated livestreaming equipment was installed in the Church, enabling services to be broadcast with the push of a button.
- **Landscaping Enhancements** – New plants and design elements were added around the Parish Center and Children's Memorial Garden, all generously donated.
- **Parish Center Windows** – Windows were replaced to improve insulation and enhance the building's appearance.



Capital Expenditures and Facility Updates Cont.

- **Interior Painting** – Communal areas in both the Parish Center and Family Life Center were repainted to create a fresh and welcoming atmosphere.
- **Guest Suite Renovations** – Cosmetic upgrades were made to the parish guest suite to improve comfort for visiting guests.
- **Hearing Loop System** – A new Hearing Loop was installed in the Church to assist parishioners who use hearing aids.
- **Baseboard Heating** – Installation of new baseboard heaters began in the Church to ensure a comfortable environment year-round.
- **St. Michael Statue** - Purchase of St. Michael Statue for Parish Grounds.
- **Studio Construction** -Construction of studio for parish podcasts and evangelization.



St. Cecelia Music Fund:

Thanks to generous donations totaling **\$8,300**, the St. Cecelia Music Fund helped offset costs for a new keyboard, supported Praise and Worship services, and provided funding for musicians at the Christmas Concert.





Week # 3 (10/18-10/19): Week Three Theme: Caring for Our Elders—End-of-Life Issues & Accompanying the Elderly, Sick, and Dying

“Pray always without becoming weary” (Lk 18:1):

Jesus tells the parable of the persistent widow, whose continual plea for justice moved even an unjust judge. If such persistence can touch the heart of one indifferent, how much more will God hear the cries of His chosen.



The widow’s cry = the cry of the vulnerable (Lk18:3)

In Scripture, widows symbolize the voiceless and forgotten. Today, their cry echoes in the lonely elder, the abandoned sick, the terminally ill. The Gospel calls us to hear and respond with compassion, not indifference. As Pope Francis warned, we must resist a “throwaway culture” that discards those no longer needed” (Fratelli Tutti 18)

Prayer of the elderly, Saint John Paul, II 1999

Grant, O Lord of life, That we may savor every season of our lives as a gift. Grant that we may lovingly accept your will, and place ourselves each day in your merciful hands. And when the moment of our definitive “passage” comes, grant that we may face it with serenity, without regret for what we shall leave behind. For in meeting you, after having sought you for so long, we shall find once more every authentic good which we have known on earth, in the company of all who have gone before us marked with the sign of faith and hope. Mary, Mother of pilgrim humanity, pray for us “now and at the hour of our death.” Keep us ever close to Jesus, your beloved Son and our brother, the Lord of life and glory, Amen.



In today’s Gospel we hear Jesus encourages us to persevere in prayer by challenging our doubt: “Will [God] be slow to answer...?” *Struggle* is real and common to us all. But consistent struggle that seems to remain, no matter the number of times we pray, strikes at the heart of our suffering. We ask “When will I be heard?” This is particularly apparent when the suffering comes from wounds inflicted by others. “Where does my help come from?” the psalmist asks. Help comes from leaning into the wound and inviting the One who promises to heal to enter into to it with us. The widow in today’s parable demonstrated this: she sought justice (leaned into her wound) and then invited the judge acknowledge it until she prevailed. We too must notice our wounds and then implore the Just Judge who promises to “...secure the rights of his chosen ones who call out to him day and night.” We may not find relief in the act of persevering – but we will find peace in the entering in with Jesus who is Peace and in his promise to respond to our perseverance. -Nellie K, LISW-S, CCTP-II, IFS, EMDR Sacred Heart Counseling Team
