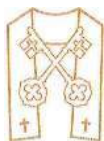

In our second reading this weekend, St. Peter tells us that it is better to suffer for doing good than to do evil. The Gospel also tells us that the Holy Spirit will not be accepted by the world. When I

reflect on these two passages together, I think of how frequently I want to feel rewarded and vindicated when I do something good, but this is not what Christ promised us, at least not in this world. There are many times we might stand up for what is right and be hated for it. My wife and I recently watched the movie “A Hidden Life” which is the story of Blessed Franz Jägerstätter, the man who refused to take Hitler’s Oath in Austria during World War II. One thing that is clear in this movie is the emotional toll it takes to stand up for what you believe is right. Sometimes we are not rewarded, praised, or vindicated for doing what is right, and feelings of rejection, sadness, and anger can follow. If this resonates with you, know that these feelings are normal and they are hard to carry. Especially if we are hated for doing good, people may not support us in these difficult feelings. However, we take heart in Christ knowing that he faced the same. We can unite that suffering to Christ’s suffering whether it is the cross that he carried or his time of agony in the garden. We can know that He is with us in our suffering, even when it does not feel like it. Lastly, I recommend watching “A Hidden Life” if you find yourself in this difficult position.

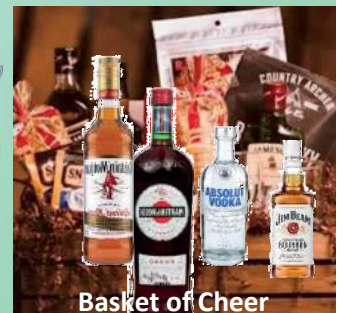
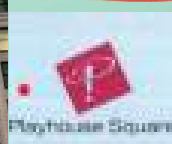

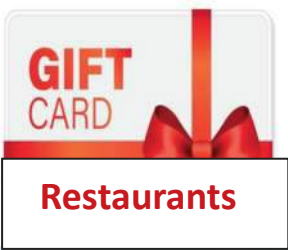

- Must be at least 16 years of age.
- Can not be a parent of the candidate.
- Able to form a relationship with the Candidate and willing to share his/her own experience of faith.
- Willing to give the time to participate in the sacramental preparation and to pray for the Candidate.

All confirmation sponsors must provide a sponsor certificate. *(Even if you are a parishioner of St. Basil Church.)*

This form will be provided by the sponsor's home parish and will need to be signed by their parish priest and returned to Katie Rosen at the Parish Office. This certificate confirms that they are a registered and participating member of the Christian community.

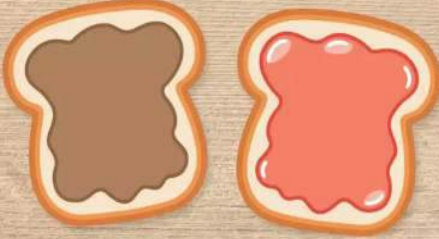
