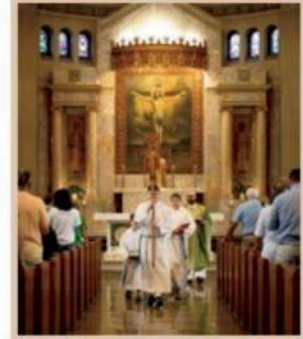



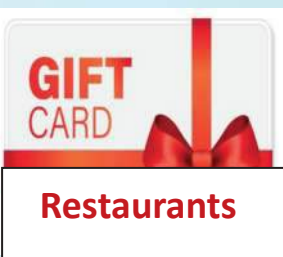

Today's Gospel is one of the most well known passages in all of Scripture. This makes sense as it is a succinct summary of the core Gospel message! However, our familiarity with this passage can cause us to lose sight of the power of its message. The idea

that the all-powerful God of the universe came down to suffer and die for me is something that should deeply move me and impact every choice and action I make. And yet we have heard the message "Jesus loves you" so often that it tends to just go in one ear and out the other. We can think to ourselves, "that's nice," without allowing that message to move us to any real action in our lives. This reminds me that, all across life, it is easy for us to take familiar things for granted. This can be true of our family members, jobs, health, homes, and more. One easy way to check to see if we have been taking things in our life for granted, is to ask ourselves, "what if I woke up tomorrow with only the things that I thanked God for today?" How much would we be left with? I know my answer is often less than I would like! The saying is that "familiarity breeds contempt," but I think that more often it breeds indifference. For me, today's Gospel is a reminder to not to let familiarity cause me to take the good in my life for granted, but to ask God to help me be truly grateful for all I have received. We can ask the Holy Spirit to fill us with the gift of Wonder and Awe (remember that from confirmation?) to see with new eyes the many gifts in our lives. Too often it takes some sort of tragedy or loss for us to realize what we have, but today's Gospel can remind us that it does not have to be that way. We can take steps today to be more grateful for everything in our lives- first and foremost for God's love, but also for the many other gifts in our lives.
